This committee would like to have a seat at the table where new job description decisions are made.  Specialty factors and job families may be added to these jobs. Some positions require completely different skillsets than others.  Entry level positions can stay Civil Service, while higher levels can be AP positions.  Is APAC providing a solutions matrix or only a problem matrix?  i. Solutions should be included in the discussion.  This could be an advisory committee that oversees these job categories.
